

Field Technician Intern

Reports to Field Crew Coordinator and/or Survey Crew Chief

A. Overall Role

The Field Technician Intern will be responsible for collecting manhole, storm sewer pipe, sanitary sewer pipe, and topographic data through GPS and measurements in communities throughout West Michigan. There will be some communication with the public in regards to field project related inquiries. He/she may also gather video documentation of manhole and pipe conditions. The Field Technician may assist with collecting topographic data through visual recognition of defective pipes via smoke. He/she may assist with construction staking with our Survey Department.

B. Requirements

The Field Technician must be:

1. Fluent in English language.
2. Able to provide proof of his/her valid MI driver's license.
3. Able to work as part of a team with minimal supervision.
4. Able to lift up to 100 pounds multiple times a day.
5. Able to walk long distances—average 5 miles a day—on varied terrain.
6. Able to work outside for up to 50 hours a week, with possible Saturday hours.
7. Willing to use personal cell phone for project communication, Prein&Newhof will provide a stipend.
8. Able to provide steel-toed work boots; Prein&Newhof will provide other safety equipment.
